Leos club history:

In 1957, Lions Jim Graver and William Ernst of the Glenside Lions Club, of Pennsylvania, USA, formed the world's first Leo Club. They selected their school colors-maroon and gold as their Leo club colors.

In October 1967, The Leo Club Program became an official program of the Lions International.

Now Leos have their own network of approximately 5500 Leo Clubs in more than 130 nations.

LEO club activities and projects enhance the community and help young people develop and practice Leadership, organization and social skills.

LEO club involvement can instill in young people a lifetime commitment to helping others.

Sponsoring a Leo club: why and how

Leo clubs sponsorship inspires Lions club members through involvement with their community's youth. Hoping the youth can bring new energy to a Lions club.

Leo clubs are also away to mentor future community leaders and help foster Future Lions.

Relationship between Lions and Leos

Leo clubs are a sponsored affiliation of Lions club. The sponsoring Lions club is responsible for guiding and counseling its Leo club. By working closely With the Leos, Lions ensure that their sponsored Leo club operates within and benefits from the policies of the LCI.

What is the ages of a Leo member?

Young people between 12 years to 18 years . After 18 years the Adult can join the Lions.

Must Leo's be Sons or Daughters of Lions ?

No! anyone can become a Leo with just asking your friends, school friends, church groups, etc.

Every person must fill out a membership application to become a Leo.

Getting Started and Planning Service Projects

Advisors can help the Leo club to plan successful and worthwhile service projects, include:

Distributing public health information

Promoting safety

Participating in literacy programs

Cleaning the environment

Assisting children

Visiting the elderly/adding the homeless

Keeping the Members interested. Planning a service project

Appoint a events committee. Identify a community need.

In addition to well-planned community service projects, other factors influence Leo membership retention.
